## **MARSP Scholarship Deadline is Approaching**

Awarding scholarships to individuals pursuing higher education or additional certifications related to our profession represents one of the most exciting things MARSP does each year. This is our opportunity to build a legacy of excellence.

Over time, we have given scholarships to students just beginning their undergraduate programs in education, to teachers working on master's degrees in reading, counseling, and educational leadership, and to several individuals seeking to complete alternative certification. The MARSP scholarship is unique in that it is a cash award, allowing the recipient the professional discretion to use the \$2,500 award to their best advantage in their school program. Most use the money for tuition, but others have purchased textbooks, computers and calculators – equipment issued in public high schools, but not at public universities.

The scholarship application can be accessed on the Midland Association of Retired School Professionals website at <https://www.midlandretireded.org/>. When the page opens, go to the box in the top left-hand corner and click on MARSP documents. The Scholarship Form is the second listed. Click on it and you will find the directions. The process is not cumbersome, but the application is due on or before February 28, 2026. Winner(s) will be announced at our May 2026 meeting. Please spread the word to anyone you know who may be interested in making an application. It's exciting to help build and support our profession. We may be retired, but we are still interested, engaged, and making a valuable contribution.

## **TRS Legislative News**

TRS conducts annual actuarial valuations through an independent consulting group. These valuations offer important insights into the health and long-term outlook of the pension fund. The most recent results, presented to the TRS Board of Trustees on December 5, 2025, delivered disappointing news for retirees hoping for a cost-of-living increase. Achieving actuarial soundness is essential, as it is the threshold required by TRS to approve a cost-of-living increase for retired educators.
