- Notice of award(s) will be made on or before April 15, 2023 and announced at the MARSP meeting on May 4, 2024.
- Recipients(s) will be invited to join MARSP for lunch and the May 2024 meeting.
- Recipient(s) must submit proof of enrollment at a college or university before receiving scholarship award.
